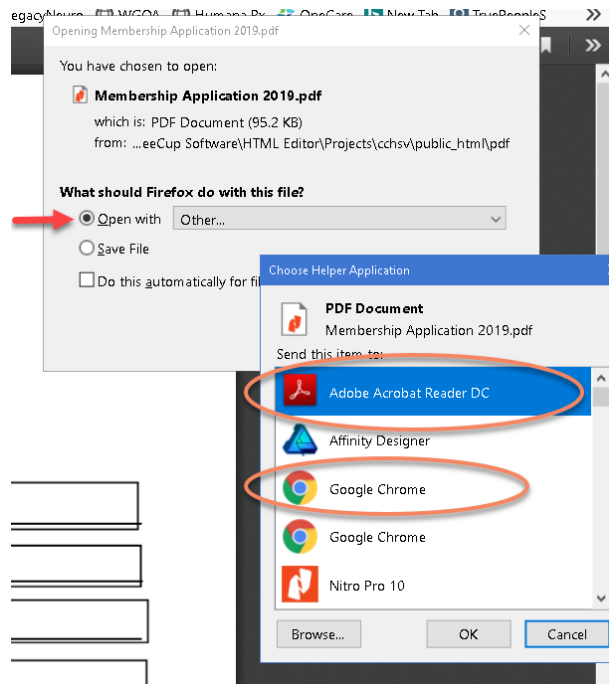
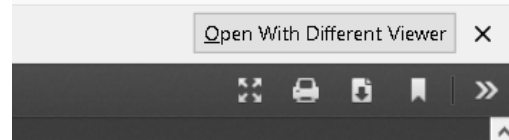


Additional steps to fill in PDF form in Firefox

The Firefox browser will not allow you to fill out pdf forms in its default pdf viewer. You will need to open the form in another viewer. There will be a button in the upper right of the browser window to allow you to do this:

“Click the open in a different viewer” button and choose the one you want (assuming you have a PDF viewer installed.)



You should choose the default viewer listed by the red arrow (picture on the left). If you want to pick another viewer than the default, just choose other in that box and you will get a list of programs to choose from. You can use Acrobat or even Chrome as the viewer.

Then you can continue to fill out the form and print.

Saving a filled in PDF form to your hard drive.

If you use the Edge browser, you can save the filled in form with no additional work.

If you use the Chrome browser, right-click on the page and choose “save as”. Just clicking the download button on the page will save a blank form, not the filled in one.

If you use Acrobat Viewer, you will need to press CTRL-S to save as the save button is greyed out.
